

**BRIDGEWATER TOWNSHIP  
HIGHWAY OCCUPANCY PERMIT POLICY FOR  
SEISMIC TESTING/VIBRATORY TRUCKS**

- \* Permittee is responsible for following and adhering to all Federal and PENDOT Traffic Control regulations and/or statutes
- \* Permittee is responsible for adhering to all Bridgewater Township regulations and ordinances
- \* Township roads are to be open for public use, seismic company cannot close or block roads from public use
- \* Emergency vehicles, mail carriers, school buses must have clear passage at all times
- \* Township must be notified a minimum of 48 hours before vibratory trucks are operated on Township roads
- \* Township is not responsible for any damage to cables crossing or along side of road. Township will not take any special precautions to avoid cables while performing road maintenance
- \* No cables, instruments etc. are to be placed inside ditch line except where necessary for road crossings
- \* Cables placed along roads should be placed between ditch line and edge of right of way
- \* Township will be reimbursed for cost of damage repairs, additional administrative costs, Wait time caused by seismic activity
